



Intro to Eswatini

Eswatini is one of the few remaining monarchies in Africa, it is a diverse and vibrant nation and boasts a **rich culture and heritage**.

The people of Eswatini are **peaceful and friendly**, the country has never been touched by war.

The **natural landscapes** of mountains and forest are beautiful and vast. Not to mention hosts of the 'Big Five' and other stunning wildlife.



Orphans

HIV/AIDS has wiped out a generation of adults, rendering Eswatini a country of orphaned and/or vulnerable children.

Water

In rural areas many people are miles away from clean and safe drinking water.

Unemployment

With limited job opportunities due to lack of industry within the country, poverty is expected to rise throughout the nation.

Medical

In rural areas medical care is very far away. For any specialist treatment people have to **travel** out of country to South Africa.





27.3%

27.3% of the population in Eswatini has HIV. This is the highest HIV prevalence rate in the world.

24 years

Due to the devastation of the HIV pandemic, 24 years is the average age of a person in Eswatini.

300,000

The number of children who are orphaned and/or vulnerable today in Eswatini.

61 years

Eswatini has one of the lowest life expectancies in the world at 61 years.

58%

This is the current youth unemployment rate, due to weak job creation in the formal economy.







Challenge Ministries Swaziland

We are a Christian organisation that works throughout Eswatini. Our mission is to **raise a nation of kingdom leaders**, one life at a time. Our holistic approach works with the individual, our vision is to raise up a generation of Godly, educated leaders who will transform the nation of Eswatini.

We do this through the following 4 key initiatives:



01

Childcare

We operate a **residential childcare program** for orphaned and/or vulnerable children. We believe that children should grow up in a home, not an institutionalised orphanage. Our model places the child in a family-style community equipped with love, spiritual guidance, education and healthcare.

02

Rehabilitation

We run residential **rehabilitation programs** at our men's centre and women's centre for those affected by addiction, abuse and poverty. The 12 month program works to restore and rebuild the individual, and then give them the skills they need to re-enter the workforce and thrive.



03

Sustainability

Our goal is to become a **self-sustaining organisation**. We run several enterprises, creating our own income streams, whilst employing the people of Eswatini. Our enterprises currently consist of hospitality, honey, dairy, bakery and essential oils.

04

ICBC

We have developed an initiative to **reach the rural areas** of the country, most affected by poverty. The ICBC model (in community by community) consists of a church plant, a preschool and a water source - all powered by solar energy which holistically cares for the local community. We currently have 28 ICBC sites across the country, each spanning a 5 mile radius.
