It seems such a short time ago but it is some eight months since you all, through donations and fundraising, ensured that our children's, abused ladies, addicted men and feeding ministries survived the huge impact of Coronavirus on our country and people.

Since then the true impact of coronavirus has been measured, not by deaths but by economic demise, as our country in lockdown went from unemployment of 22% to currently 24.8%. The Ministry of Labour announced that 13 companies had laid off over 8,400 workers and there are 43 companies that have applied to lay off their staff.

Eswatini's economy is expected to contract by 3.5%, which is 6 percentage point below the pre-pandemic baseline according to IMF. The closure of the country's Hotel and Tourism industry means a huge loss of 1 billion Rands annual revenue from this industry alone.

World Vision estimated one million girls across sub Saharan Africa may be blocked from returning to school due to pregnancy during COVID 19 school closure. In Eswatini, teen-age pregnancy snatches a large amount of girls out of school annually according to the Swazi Observer.

Our country is in economic collapse and the result is widespread hunger, illness, crime, and hopelessness without money and help. Your desire to send a container of food, clothing and essential equipment is truly a lifesaving act and one which we cannot thank you enough for. Only eternity will reveal the impact once again of the love in action of the Northern Ireland people, unrivalled by any other country we know. God bless you all.

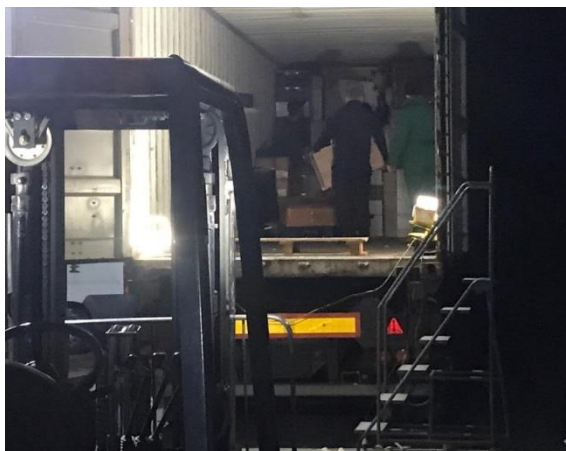
